

The following table will help you to identify occupations that may be a good match for your personality type. Occupations are listed by their two-letter Holland code—the abbreviation for their two principal personality types. The six Holland personality types are defined in the introduction.

The abbreviations used here are as follows: R=Realistic, I=Investigative, A=Artistic, S=Social, E=Enterprising, and C=Conventional. The codes are arranged alphabetically, and occupations that share the same code are arranged numerically by O\*NET code.

Note that you may find it useful to consider both combinations of your primary and secondary personality types. For example, if your primary type is Artistic and your secondary type is Social, you may want to look at occupations coded AS and SA.
